
Dallas, Texas January 21

Continuing in our series on Acts, we came to the famous sign-and-sermon chapter in which Peter heals a lame man. That healing illustrates not only the power of Jesus to provide physical healing of individuals, but it also illustrates His power to heal the nation of Israel. If that generation of Jews were to come to faith in Jesus and repent of their sins, then the kingdom would come in their lifetimes, within 7 years (after the Tribulation, which would have begun immediately).

Peter reoffered the kingdom to Israel in a great expression of God's grace (Acts 3:19-26). How amazing is grace that allows a generation that killed the Messiah an opportunity to repent and receive Him back as her King! That the nation rejected this reoffer is sad indeed. However, a day is coming soon when the nation will indeed be both believing and in fellowship with her Messiah (Rom 10:13; 11:26).
