


Home Bible Study Loveland, Colorado January 29



Commentary Is at the Printer!

For about four years now I've been saying that the commentary could be to the printer *this year*. Well, it finally is there. What a joy it is.



We had to change from one volume to two because of the massive length. The printer had told us that we could do a 1,050 page one-volume book. Well, it grew to over 1,300 pages by the end of the typesetting. We figured we'd just have to pay more. Wrong. They said it couldn't be done as one volume since only major publishers have binderies that can bind such a large book.

So, Volume 1 is Matthew

through Acts and Volume 2 is Romans to Revelation. The first volume is about 620 pages and the second around 720 pages. Actually each is plenty big enough by itself, so it is probably best we went to two volumes.

The price will be \$29.95. However, for those of you who come to the conference, it will be offered there at a special price of \$20.00. The printer tells us we should have the commentary by April 15th, four days before the conference starts.

Thanks so much for your support of this ministry and this project. It truly is surprising that we were able to do such a major project.
