

It is such a joy to meet with the GES Board. These men are committed to the Lord and His grace message. We discuss ways in which GES can continue to be faithful to what we are doing and also how we might improve.

The Board is encouraged on where we are. Finances are now back at the level they were in 2001 before the terrorist attacks on 9/11. Our conference keeps growing and registrations at this time are ahead of last year. We are adding a family camp in Tulsa this summer. In addition to my new book on assurance due out in a few weeks, we have plans to release two more books by other authors during 2005. A booklet on eternal security is in the works. The one-volume New Testament commentary is gaining momentum and we hope to have at least first drafts of every book by the end of December. A 2006 release date seems quite possible.

The Board remains convinced that the key to our success is remaining rock solid on the grace message. Doctrine matters. While there is much diversity in the Free Grace camp on non-essential issues, GES must not waver on the nature of faith, assurance being of the essence of saving faith, perseverance as commanded but not guaranteed, etc.


We have high hopes for the impact *Secure and Sure* will make. Whatever it is, you will share in the rewards at the Bema for this project since you are coworkers with us.
