GRACE LIFE CHURCH **Conference on Repentance** Anoka, MN February 10-11

Continuing my series on the Book of Acts, I explained Acts 4: "You Can Imprison the Gospel Messengers, But You Can't Imprison the Gospel." Those who proclaim the grace message are threatened by legalists. But that doesn't stop the message. The message spreads in spite of external opposition.

In the Lord's Supper message I discussed the issue of the filling of the Holy Spirit. The filling referred to in Acts 4 was, I believe, special enablement for a special task. The other type of filling of the Spirit is described in Acts 6:3 and refers to being spiritual or mature in the faith. I suggested that Eph 5:18 refers to this second type of filling, to spiritual maturity.
