### Spotlight on Your Support

We have been in discussions with Kerugma about GES buying all of the copyrights to Zane's writings, both those already published and those scheduled to be published, like his Romans commentary and his commentary on 2 Peter. While we do not yet have a formal agreement, we have an agreement in principle and hope to finalize it in April.

We have created a new fund for publications. This new fund will be used to pay for the printing of Zane's works. Money for the purchase of the copyrights has already been promised. This additional money would strictly be used for printing and related costs (like graphic design, typesetting, and marketing).

Over the next five years, here are some of the things we hope to publish with a guess at possible publication dates: Commentary on Second Peter (2009, part of our one-volume commentary), Commentary on Romans and The Gospel under Siege (2010?), Revised and expanded version of Jesus God's Prophet (2010), Revised and expanded version of Harmony with God (2011), Revised and expanded version of Absolutely Free! A Biblical Reply to Lordship Salvation (2012), Revised and expanded version of Six Secrets of the Christian Life (2013). Of course, these goals are ambitious. We might need to hire an additional part-time staff member just to make these things happen. We will keep you posted.
