Ft. Worth, TX ~ April 19-22

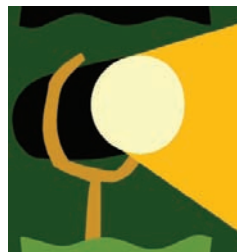
