One of the more puzzling and amazing passages in Scripture is Gen 6:1-8. Moses tells of a time when "the sons of God" married "the daughters of men" and had offspring that were giants. Who in the world, or who in the universe, are "the sons of God"?

I believe, as do many commentators, that the sons of God are fallen angels. Compare 2 Pet 2:4-5. Their offspring were a new race, a new species, half human and half fallen angel. When their offspring died in the flood, they became what we call demons.

I discussed other interpretations in the sermon, which you can hear online via our website. But if the view I suggest is true, it lets us realize that there many things which we do not know. We only know what God has chosen to reveal to us. Much more will be learned when we go to be with the Lord, and, I imagine, we will keep on learning every day of eternity.

The lesson of Gen 6:1-8 is that God is in charge. Neither humans nor fallen angels nor an alliance between the two can thwart God's plan.

Spotlight on Your Support

It appears we set the price of our 2-volume commentary a bit too low. It probably should have sold for \$39.95 or at least \$34.95. Many who have called to order it have commented how cheap a 1334 page 2-volume hardback commentary is for just \$29.95.

We are actually losing \$2 to \$3 per commentary for those sold on Amazon. However, the Board feels it is worth •it since we get the grace message into the hands of people who wouldn't have it otherwise. (We probably will charge •\$34.95 if and when we reprint so that we at least break even on Amazon orders.)

Commentary Sales Picking Up

After selling 460 commentaries at the April 19-22 conference, sales in May were steady at about 45 a week. June sales nearly doubled, with sales averaging 85 per week. Amazon has already ordered nearly 50 this month.

We printed 5,000 in the first (hopefully first of many) printing, figuring that it would take six to twelve months to sell them. It is too early to be very accurate at analyzing sales, but it seems likely that we may average sales of over 300 per month for the second half of the year. If we do, we probably will need to reprint the commentary about a year from now.

I have completed the translation and commentary through Rom 16:18, leaving me just 9 verses to go. Hopefully I will complete the commentary by early July. Dr. John Niemelä should be done with the Introduction to Romans by early July as well. Then he will seek to complete the scholarly footnotes by the end of August. We are still shooting for a release date of late 2010 or early 2011.

My point is that we are able to sell the commentary so cheaply because of you, our Partners. Without your financial support, we'd have to charge a lot more for all our materials and sales would be much less.

This is a very exciting time for our ministry with the. NT commentary, Zane's commentary on Romans, my book on ten words, and re-releases of Zane's out of print works.


Prayer Requests
