But this time Leon gave me a lot of grace on the time so I went a bit long.



In December we have worked hard on both Zane's commentary on Romans and his trilogy (*The Hungry Inherit*, *The Gospel Under Siege*, *Grace in Eclipse*). We need to have these to the printer by the end of January so that we can then get the March-April newsletter and Spring Journal done on time. It looks iffy that we will have both ready to go by the end of this month, and if so, we will have them both at this year's conference. It is still possible, but we really need to accomplish a lot in January.

My new book, The Ten Most Misunderstood Words in the Bible, is on hold since these two Hodges publications were higher priority. Another reason is that I realize it might be better to come out with a book on hell, one of the ten words, before we release this book. After the conference I should be able to focus on both books and hopefully have one of them to the printer by the end of the summer.


Prayer Requests

I just wanted to say thank you for your work on Grace Evangelical Society.
