The inmates in this program complete a two-year theology degree from Columbia International

Seminary. After they finish, the state sends them to other correctional facilities in the state to help with the chaplains and teach Bible studies.

This is an exciting ministry since the students in the program are allowed access to the other inmates in the prison. They engage in evangelism and Bible studies. Ken wants to make sure they proclaim the Biblical Gospel and that their theology is Biblical as well.
