Since some people already have subscriptions, if we find out that someone you sign up is already subscribed, we will notify you and give you the chance to give it to someone else.

We do ask that you send an email or letter to the people or institutions you give a free journal subscription and let them know that the first issue, Autumn 2013, should be received in November.
