
Genesis 33 deals with Jacob's return to the Promised Land and his reconciliation with his estranged brother Esau. Both men are shown to be changed men. God has changed them both. Esau is no longer angry toward his brother and planning on killing him. Jacob has been humble (bowing seven times to Esau) and generous (in his gifts to his brother).

Several of the applications of this passage are 1) expect God to change you and your believing loved ones, 2) rejoice when you see changes in your life and the lives of others, 3) do not fear those who oppose the faith since God is able to give us victory over our enemies.

The Ten Most Misunderstood Words in the Bible Should Be to the Printer Soon

The ten words are faith, everlasting, saved, lost, heaven, hell, repentance, grace, gospel, and judgment. We have been trying hard to get this to the printer by March 1st so it would be ready for the conference.

This book has essentially been done for over a year. But I've continued to tweak it. The chapter on hell was especially hard to write. On key words like these, it is dif-



ficult to decide what to say and what not to say. The book has ended up a little over 200 pages. However, it easily could have been much longer. I worked hard to keep each chapter relatively short.

As of February 24th as I write this, we have it typeset and we have the cover, spine, and back cover. We are in the process of final proofing. We still anticipate having it in print by the conference. If we can get it to the printer the week of March 5th, then it should be in print by the April 23rd start of the conference. We would appreciate your prayers.
