

International Ministry in Madrid, Spain

February 8-16

Sharon and I flew out of Dallas at 6PM on Friday night. We arrived in Madrid at 10AM Saturday morning local time (3AM Dallas time). Adjusting to the seven hour time difference was challenging, especially the first two days.

Our hosts were Manny Fernandez III and his wife, Jamie. Manny is a DTS graduate and a Free Grace

guy. His dad, Manuel (or Manny) heads World Link Ministries. Manny and Jamie have lived in Paracuellos (pronounced par-ah-qwayyoss), a suburb of Madrid, for five years, and



head a seminary and have started a church too.

I spoke on Sunday at church (Matt 16:24-28) and on Tuesday through Friday from 9AM till 1:00 PM on the doctrine of salvation. There were 20 to 25 young adults, mostly ages 20 to 35. About half did not believe in eternal security before the conference began. By the end, a number of them had come to believe it and all seemed open to it.



At the break on Friday a woman told me that she had already put the teaching to good use. The previous day she had led her 10-year-old daughter to assurance of her eternal destiny by sharing with her what we had discussed in class concerning Jesus' promise of everlasting life that can never be lost. The daughter thanked her mother profusely and started crying for joy. The mom did as well.

After the final session on Friday, a young man indicated that he had gained assurance of everlasting life at the conference. He did not believe in eternal security before the conference. He said that it had already made a profound impact on him. He said he felt so grateful now. He desired to serve Christ out of love rather than fear of hell.

On Thursday Manny told me he received emails and text messages from several of the students who indicated they thought this was a fantastic conference.



Sharon and I arrived home on Saturday evening after a 10.5 hour flight exhausted and invigorated. What a great trip. Thank you all for making such trips possible.
