This was my second half marathon in just 4 months. And I was 7 minutes faster this time (2 hours 45 minutes as compared to 2 hours 52 minutes in December). It was a very windy day, with winds up to 50 MPH. I had a great time racewalking. But I sure was sore the next few days afterwards. Next time I think I'll either train better (my long walk was only 10 miles two weeks before, and this is a 13.1 mile race) or go slower.

It is good to know I can still finish a half. This November I hope to do a marathon again. But if so, I think this will be my first one over 6 hours since it is a difficult course (8 and a half laps of a lake on a jogging trail). I think I'll shoot for under 7 hours.

*Bible* by me are on sale for just \$0.99 in the Amazon Kindle store. We put these on sale during the conference and sales have skyrocketed.


Consider the following: if you find you like these books on Kindle, you try giving away 10 copies of each to family and friends. It is an inexpensive way to get the message out.
