Logos Mobile Education Course on Free Grace Theology (FGT) Bellingham, WA March 13-19

My thanks to GES Partner Bill Fiess who convinced Logos what it would be a good idea to invite me (Bob) to present a week-long course for Logos Mobile Education.

Sharon and I flew to SeaTac and then drove to Bellingham. Sharon was able to go to Victoria, Canada, for a few days with GES Partner Babbette Tyler.

This course has 70 segments which average around 10 minutes each. When it is available there will be around 12 hours of video which you can play on Logos, if you have the software, or on your phone, laptop, Apple

TV, TV using Roku, etc. This course should be great for Sunday School, home Bible studies, discipleship groups, homeschooling, Bible colleges, seminaries, etc.

I cover the following nine areas: saving faith, assurance, accountability (the Judgment Seat of Christ and the Great White Throne Judgment), sanctification via the Word, Lordship Salvation, FGT in Church History, FGT in relation to Calvinism and Arminianism, FGT's understanding of key words, and FGT's understanding of key tough texts.

The Lord blessed greatly during the filming. Walter and Daniel and I worked very well together. Everyone at Logos was very friendly to me and Sharon. It was a very enjoyable week.

The course will go on pre-sale sometime in the next few months. I recommend you buy it then if you are interested as it will be around half price (that is, around \$150 to \$200 instead of \$250 to \$350). Ken in Prison Bishopville, SC March 14

A seminary in South Carolina has an outreach to the prisoners in the state, where they give a two-year degree to prisoners who complete the classes they offer inside the prison.

On March 14, Ken Yates was asked to speak at the completion of a Bible study led by one of the prisoner graduates, which included communion.

Pictures are not allowed in the prison, but this is Ken outside of the prison in Bishopviille, SC. It is a maximum security prison and the study had about 40 students.

Ken spoke on the assurance of salvation from the Gospel of John and the certainty of Christ's return. Ken

and one of the chaplains in the prison have introduced the leader of the study to free grace material. He is very excited about it and constantly reads and studies the books that come from GES.
