Logos Mobile Education Course on Free Grace Theology: Done

For much of February I was in the zone. I was very focused on getting this course done.

Logos is the leading software program for studying the Bible. GES Partner Bill Fiess urged them to have me offer a course on Free Grace Theology, and they agreed.

Logos (now called FaithLife) wanted me to manuscript every session. They wanted about 60 sessions of 5 to 10 minutes in length.

I ended up writing 63 sessions, with most being 1,000 words or a bit more. My guess is that all together there is over 60,000 words, which is about the size of a 300-page book.

This course will be filmed at their studios in Bellingham, WA, from March 14-18. It should end up being a 6 to 8 hour course which would be excellent for Sunday school classes, Bible studies, or Bible college or seminary courses. Since it will be made up of over 60

sessions of 5 to 10 minutes, it would be easy to play a short session and then make the rest of the class session a discussion of that topic or passage. (Pastors could also use this to play short videos in their sermons.)

New Publications

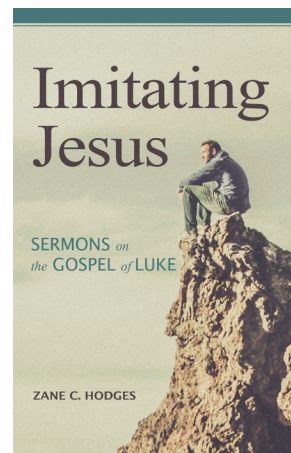
Work is nearing completion on six titles.

We are reprinting Hodges' sermons on Luke as a one-volume, indexed edition: *Imitating Jesus: Sermons on the Gospel of Luke*. We're also re-printing a newly typeset and indexed collection of Hodges' sermons on Hebrews, as *The Journey of Faith: Sermons on Hebrews*.

We also have four new books just about ready to go to press: *Tough Texts* by Hodges and Wilkin; *What Is the Outer Darkness?* by Hodges and Wilkin; *Kept from Stumbling: An Exposition of Jude* by Hodges; and finally, *Christ's Companions: Notes on Hebrews* by Hodges. We're hoping all will be at the conference.

Also in the works: *Chosen to Serve* by Shawn; *Beyond All Doubt*, by Shawn; *The Acts of the Risen Christ* by Hodges; *Showstoppers for Calvinism* by Wilkin; a collection of sermons on John by Wilkin; a book on inerrancy by Wilkin; and two more volumes by Hodges on Revelation and 1 Peter.
