After the Conference, Shawn was invited to preach at Kelty Evangelical Church in Kelty, Scotland. It was a Plymouth Brethren Assembly that nearly died out, but under the faithful ministering of John and Margaret Langlands (who helped organize the conference and acted as our hosts for part of our trip), it has grown from 8 people to about 40, with several young couples.

Shawn had prepared a sermon, but due to time constraints chose to deliver an extemporaneous sermon on John 3:16 instead, dividing that verse into five basic concepts: the Divine Motivation (love of the world), the Divine Action (giving Jesus to die for the world), the Condition (belief in Jesus), the Consequence (everlasting
