Luis Rodriguez and I alternated speaking in September. He spoke on *Defending the Gospel* on September 4. I spoke on *The Lord's Supper and Walking with Christ* the next Sunday. Then Luis spoke on *Rewards and Loss of Rewards* on September 18. The last Sunday I spoke on *The Second Coming of Christ*, in which I overviewed everything from the Rapture to the New Heavens and the New Earth. Each Sunday Luis and I fielded questions for about 30 minutes. The Q & A time was great.

September 17

Ken Yates was invited to speak at a local Spanish speaking church on how Greek can help us understand the New Testament.

Ken spoke on the passage in Mark 8 that deals with Jesus' teaching on taking up one's cross and following Him. He pointed out that in most Spanish as well as English translations, there is a change in the word "life"



to "soul." Ken showed how the Greek word, however, is the same throughout. Jesus is not saying a person can lose their "soul" (or "alma" in Spanish), but that a person can waste or lose their life by how they live.

Ken just hoped he did not butcher the Spanish to the point that they did not understand what he was saying. The people did say they understood and that it shed new light on the passage.

teach at a seminary there. He has been able to help in a New Testament Survey class. Ken was able to show that in 1 Thessalonians 5 Paul is not saying that dead believers will be raptured, but that even those believers who are not looking for the Lord's return will be raptured. The word for "dead" is different than the word "dead" in chapter four. Ken will be with the class for two weeks.

Please pray for the possibility of doing these trips on a recurring basis. The school is very interested in having Ken come whenever he can. They are even looking into having some classes in English.

Filming Lots of Short Videos in September

Brad filmed Bob and Shawn, and sometimes just Bob, speaking on about a dozen topics. Each video was around 2 to 3 minutes in length. It will take a month or so before we release them since Brad has to merge several cameras, edit the sound, add headings, an introduction, and a conclusion.

This month we released a video on eternal security which we had done previously. Over 5,000 people saw the video in a week! This included many new people.

Logos Course on Free Grace Theology Pre-Sale Started September 29th

Back in March Logos filmed me (Bob) speaking for about 12 hours on Free Grace Theology. There were about 72 short segments of around 10 minutes in length each.

That course was made available for pre-sale at the end of September. As soon as sales are large enough, possibly within a month or two, the course will be
