The board is especially pleased with how well our daily blogs and daily podcasts are doing. The board decided to drop the comments on our blogs since they

have become ineffective.

We hope to have the revised NT commentary back in print by Christmas.

The service was well attended with approximately 120 in attendance. It was a great opportunity to proclaim the message of grace. Lord willing this will be an opportunity in the future to teach Free Grace in a place where it is hard to find.
