Shawn and his three kids drove over to Shreveport where he spoke on the subject of hospitality. Much of what passes for "Christian spirituality" seems to focus on the wrong things (e.g., rock concerts, candles, icons, sacred spaces, meditative prayer, ecstatic utterances, etc). But what kinds of things does God tell us to focus on? Shawn traced the importance of *hospitality* in the NT—showing it is part of loving your neighbor; a qualification for being an elder; the setting for the early house churches; the character of celebrating the Lord's Supper in the context of a meal; and one means of church discipline (i.e., by not showing hospitality).
