

#### **Mid-Year Financial Report**

Our fiscal year runs from July 1st to June 30th. We just hit the halfway point of our fiscal year. We had a great first half.

A GES partner who went to be with the Lord in 2022 left GES a huge endowment. We received \$100,000 in September and \$200,000 in December. GES Chairman Brad Doskocil emailed after I shared the news of the December gift: "Great news! Another \$200K to finance getting God's message of everlasting life out to as many as can hear!" Amen.

Thank you to all of you who support this ministry with your finances and prayers. We are having a major impact that is far beyond our small size.

Budget \$322,866 Revenue \$658,754\*

\$300,000 of that revenue will go towards reserves, to be used, as Brad said, for future ministry. Our budget for our next fiscal year will likely expand significantly.
