#### **Mid-Year Financial Report**

We had a great first half of our fiscal year.

A Free Grace church in Colorado closed its doors and gave GES \$390,000. A board committee spoke with the former pastor and his elders. The entire GES board gave \$50,000 to the pastor's non-profit ministry to help him plant a new church.

The board decided the remaining \$340,000 would be separated into a Special Projects Fund. The projects we have discussed are supporting church planting, creating Bible study materials, adding more radio stations, and aiding internationals in coming to our annual conference.
