

Debating the Gospel Online

I (Bob) debated Sean Griffin on the Standing for Truth online platform. Donny Budinsky was the moderator.

It was challenging to debate Sean because he was hard to follow, went overtime on his answers, and held very odd views.

I asked him about the past tense in James 1:18, "He brought us forth by the word of truth." "Is that talking about being born again in the past?" He said, "No." When I asked when the readers were born again, he said it was

proleptic, meaning that they would be born again if they persevered in obedience to God's commandments until death.

"Does any living person have everlasting life?" "No. It is future."

He said John 3:16 means, "He who keeps until death the Father's commandment will have everlasting life."

I hope the debate helped many understand the promise of everlasting life and the concept of eternal rewards. I was surprised that over 6,000 people viewed the debate in the first six days on Donny and Sean's YouTube channels. We posted the first of three parts on the GES YouTube channel on April 24, and it received over 700 views in

the first 24 hours. Parts 2 & 3 will be posted on May 1 and May 8.

New Books for Conference

The first three weeks in April were spent editing and proofing three books: a combined commentary of 1-2 Peter and Jude by Zane Hodges, a John Bible study book by me (Bob), and a John teacher's guide.
